Crossing borders goes easily for artists, especially within the European Union but also to other countries. But with working abroad it may be that other tax and social security rules apply, which can lead to administrative hurdles and even double taxation. Very often foreign visits are for short periods and in different countries, which does not make it always possible to study the foreign rules. Back home the foreign income needs to be reported as part of the worldwide income and will be taxed again and then information about foreign taxation and other levies becomes important.

This workshop gives much practical information and examples about how artists can deal with:

- national tax rules and rates, bilateral tax treaties and how to eliminate double taxation
- EU rules for social security and national measures
- VAT rules for cross-border work within and outside the EU

The workshop will be given by Dick Molenaar, who has much practical experience with these topics as partner with All Arts Tax Advisers and researcher at the Erasmus University, Rotterdam.
